### Flu & H1N1

#### **Know the signs of the flu.**

Symptoms of the flu include fever (100 degrees F or greater), cough, sore throat, a runny or stuffy nose, body aches, headache and feeling very tired. Some people may also vomit or have diarrhea.

#### **Do not send children to school if they are sick.**

Any child who is determined to be sick while at school *will* be sent home. We will not send a child home with a known fever on the school bus.

**Keep your child home if your child has a fever for at least 24 hours after there is no fever.** This means a child should be off of fever-reducing medicine and maintain normal temperature for 24 hours.
